

Ten Reasons Why Borrowing is not God's Best

1. It makes one a servant to the lender. – Proverbs 22:7
2. It is contrary to every building program in Scripture. Ex.: Tabernacle, Temple, Wells, Ark, Prophet's school, etc.
3. A poor example of stewardship: it constitutes judgement. – I Peter 5:3; Deut. 28:15, 44
4. It presumes upon the future. – James 4:13-17; Psalm 37:21
5. It brings division in church spirit (not of one accord).
6. It detracts from the New Testament emphasis of investing in lives. – Romans 12:13
7. It hinders God from revealing His power by supernatural provision. – II Chronicles 16:9
8. It overrides God-given signals to wait for His timing. – Proverbs 19:2
9. It threatens the spirit of giving (“not grudgingly”). – II Corinthians 7:9
10. It reveals that the church families are not free. – II Samuel 7:2
